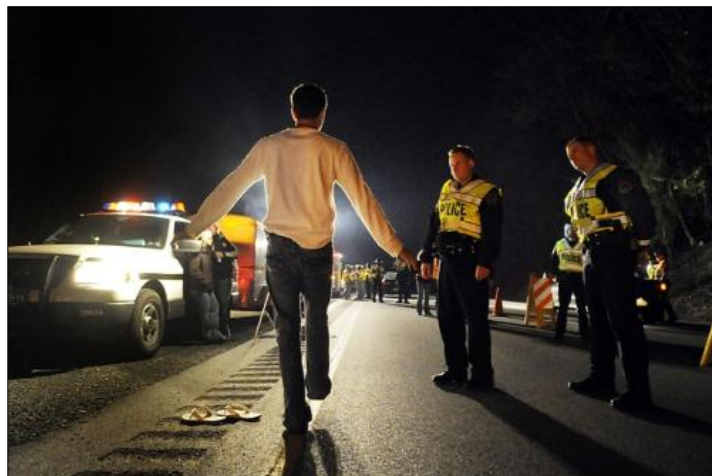
INTERESTED IN HOSTING A CLASS?

The Texas SFST Training Program offers a FREE 8-hour Fundamentals of DWI Investigation and Enforcement Course (TCOLE 3402).

This course was designed to supplement other impaired driving enforcement courses such as the Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Practitioner, SFST Refresher, and the Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) courses.

The goal of this course is to improve the skill of law enforcement officers in detecting and arresting impaired driving offenders and preparing cases for prosecution.

This course can be paired with the SFST Refresher Course (TCOLE 2177 or 2178) for a two day training and a total of 16 hours of TCOLE credit.

The mission of this program is to decrease alcohol-related crashes, injuries, and deaths by promoting DWI deterrence and enforcement proficiency.
